Dear Parent/Carer

As part of your child's continuing study towards their English Language GCSE, they have been issued with a red booklet of past and sample papers that we have produced to allow them to revise thoroughly. We strongly advise that you encourage them to complete as many of these papers in their own time as possible.

In terms of their GCSE in English Literature they will be issued with five revision guides produced in school that we have tailored to their specific exam board and set texts. They will come in five colour-coded folders, however some students may prefer to buy a larger lever arch folder to hold all five. These will be used in class and as homework and will contain essay plans, sample questions and exemplar work to enable them to prepare for their examination.

If your child wishes to write in these revision guides then to offset some of the cost we would ask for a contribution of £2.50. We feel that proper use of these revision guides is essential to the successful conclusion of the GCSE in English Literature.
