Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our commitment to providing opportunity and experience in your child's post 16 choices, we are offering Y10 students the chance to visit up to four of the following colleges to sample lessons or workshops at those colleges. The dates for each college are detailed below:

Date	Post-16 Provider	Courses on offer
Monday 24 th June	Wigan and Leigh College Non-school uniform	Vocational and A Level Honours Program
Wednesday 26 th June	Runshaw College Non-school uniform	A-level only/Vocational only or a combination of both
Wednesday 3 rd July	Wigan Warriors Sports College Non-school uniform	Level 2/3 National Diploma in Sports
Thursday 4 th July	St John Rigby College Non-school uniform	A-level only/Vocational only or a combination of both
Monday 8 th July	Winstanley College Non-school uniform	A level only

Please note that once the students have decided which subjects they want to sample they **will not** be allowed to change their mind regarding which college they wish to attend, or the subject choices they make. When the students choices have been confirmed, a further letter will be sent home with specific details about expectations, transport, meals, uniform etc.

Any place offered on an educational visit is conditional and may subsequently be reviewed by the Futures team and/or the Senior Leadership Team of the school and if a student's presence is identified as being potentially prejudicial to the health and safety of those participating in the visit, he/she may be withdrawn.

Students are welcome to sample up to four of the five colleges on offer. We encourage all students to take this opportunity to visit and see what various colleges have to offer. However, if students do not wish to attend any of the college sampling days, they **MUST** attend school as normal in full school uniform.
